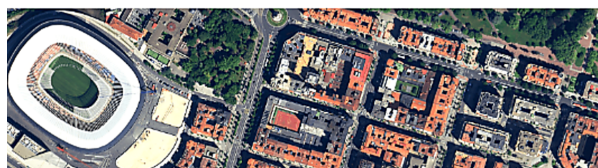

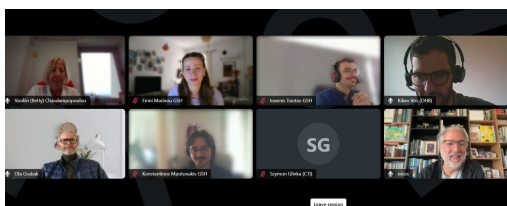

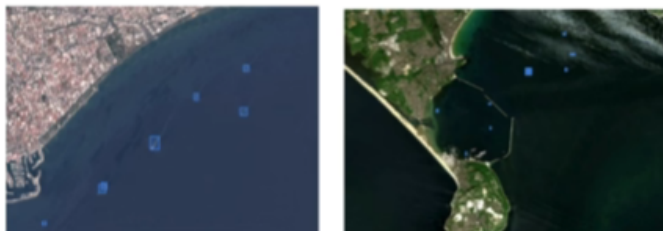


EO4PORT – The Port of the Future

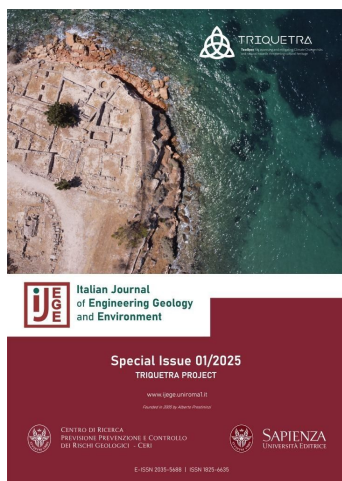

EURMARS 23/10 Final review meeting - End of project

GEOSYSTEMS HELLAS S.A. delivered an end-to-end vessel detection solution using Object-Based Image Analysis (OBIA) to effectively analyze multispectral, SAR (Synthetic Aperture Radar), and RGB imagery and video. Central to this is a novel Earth Observation (EO) data processor that ingests and processes diverse open-access and commercial EO datasets in a unified, streamlined workflow, providing end users with timely, reliable insights into potentially significant maritime events and activities.
